Dear All-Star Player,

REPORTING TO CAMP: All players **MUST** arrive at camp **by 9 a.m. on Sunday June 23, 2024**. We need to know as soon as possible if you cannot arrive on time. It is recommended that players do **NOT** drive themselves to camp. Players will be transported via team bus from camp to game site and will not return to camp site following the game. Anyone driving their own car will be required to check in his keys and will not be allowed to drive until after the game. If transportation is a problem, please let us know so we can help make the necessary arrangements.

All dates/times are subject to change. Please reference www.KansasShrineBowl.com/Camp for important information updates. Also, please regularly check your email address provided on your player information forms for updated information and important correspondence.

PROVIDED FOR YOU AT CAMP:

- Practice jersey and pants. These items must be returned at the conclusion of camp. You may bring your own practice attire if you prefer.
- Game jersey and pants. The game jersey is yours to keep, however, the game pants must be returned after the conclusion of the game.
- You will also receive a moldable mouth guard, which you may keep. Bringing your own personal mouth guard is recommended.
- Thigh pads and knee pads will be available. These pads must be returned at the conclusion of the game. If you prefer, you may bring your own thigh and knee pads.
- There are a limited number of girdles that may be available at camp. It is highly recommended that you provide your own girdle.
- You will be given three Shrine Bowl T-shirts. These are yours to keep. You will be wearing these at various dinners and events. Washers and dryers are available for your use during camp.

YOU MUST BORROW YOUR HELMET AND SHOULDER PADS FROM YOUR HIGH SCHOOL. Please don't wait until the last minute to clear this with your high school coach or A.D. All players must bring their own shoulder pads and helmet.

ACCOMMODATIONS: Dorms will be provided for players at camp and at the game. No room arrangements will be made for players on Saturday night after the game. Hotel rooms for family and friends coming to Emporia for the game weekend should be booked as early as possible. Hotel information can be found at www.KansasShrineBowl.com/Hotels.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation to camp is the responsibility of the player. We recommend players be dropped off at camp by a parent. Any player who drives themselves to camp will not be allowed access to their vehicle while at camp. All transportation after arrival at camp will be provided by the Kansas Shrine Bowl via team buses. All players must be picked up at the stadium following the conclusion of the game on Saturday, June 29th. No transportation will be provided back to camp sites following the game.

CHECK OUT: Parents may meet players at the dorms to pack up their personal gear early on game day. The dorm checkout time is 12:30 pm to 2:30 pm on Saturday, June 29th. Following the game, both locker rooms will be closed to all persons except players, Shrine Bowl coaches, trainers, managers, and Shriners helping to sort and pack equipment. There is no media, friends, family, or fans permitted in the locker rooms.
