1. Students may not leave campus without a band staff member or advisor.
2. Students will be housed in the dorms at Fort Hays State University. Students are expected to be in their rooms by 11:15 PM each night. A room check will be conducted by camp staff at this time.
3. Please no bunking or moving beds. There will be an inspection of rooms.
4. Linens and towels will not be provided. Students should bring their own sheets (Twin XL) as well as a pillow, blanket, bath towels, footwear for showers and any necessary personal toiletries.
5. Members of the opposite sex will not be permitted in the dorm rooms or adjacent halls.
6. Dr. Peter Lillpopp and his band staff from Fort Hays State University will be in charge of all musical direction of camp. Students are under the supervision of the band staff during practices and performances and will be supervised by the Shrine Bowl camp staff at all other activities.
7. All music will be made available for download at least one month prior camp. You will receive an email with information on where to download the music when it is available. It is your responsibility to familiarize yourself with the music prior to camp. Printed music will be provided for each student at the first practice of camp.
8. Students should wear comfortable clothing and shoes. Shirts must be worn at all times. Informal (but respectable) clothing will be appropriate for the entire week. Please remember you are also representing your parents, your school, your community and your sponsor.
9. Band uniform consists of five t-shirts. These t-shirts will be provided for you at check-in. You will need to bring two pairs of black shorts or capris to be worn during band performances. Please no leggings, sport shorts or short shorts. Please bring white shoes (preferably) that are comfortable and white socks (preferably).
10. Additional shorts and socks should be brought for practices. There is no style or color requirement for practice attire, but it must still follow the guidelines of being appropriate and respectable.
11. You will be provided an identification card and room key at registration. Please wear your ID card at all times during camp. Please do not lose your room key, there will be a fee for lost keys.
12. All instruments must be provided by the student. You must also bring any needed equipment, such as valve oil, extra reeds, sticks and mallets, lyres, etc.
13. Registration will be held at Fort Hays State University on Tuesday, July 11, 2023 from 1:00 PM to 2:00 PM. Lunch will not be provided on registration day.

14. Students planning to drive their own vehicle to camp will be required to turn their keys over to the Camp Director at registration and will not be allowed to use their vehicle during camp.
15. The Kansas Masonic Foundation, nor the Kansas Shrine Bowl are responsible for lost or stolen items. Please do not bring expensive jewelry or excessive amounts of money to camp. All lodging and meals are provided during camp. However, you may want to bring a small amount of spending cash to use at vending machines and/or souvenirs.
16. The game will be on Saturday, July 15, 2023 with kickoff at 7:00 PM. Pregame festivities begin at 6:00 PM. The band will be performing during pregame and halftime of the game.
17. Check-out from the dorms will be from 3:00 PM to 4:30 PM on Saturday, July 15, 2023. During check-out time you will need to load all of your personal belongings into your parents vehicle. You may leave with your parents at the conclusion of halftime. All students will be dismissed from camp at Lewis Field Stadium following halftime.
18. All students will be required to write a thank you card to their Camp Sponsor. A thank you card will be provided for you by camp staff.
19. **No drugs or alcohol at camp. If found, police will be notified and you will be sent home.**
