1. Media camp students may not leave campus without a camp staff member or advisor.
2. Media Camp students will be housed in the dorms at Pittsburg State University. There will be two students assigned to each room, no single rooms. Students are expected to be in their rooms by 11:15 PM each night. A room check will be conducted at this time.
3. Linens and towels will not be provided. Students should bring their own sheets (Twin XL) as well as a pillow, blanket, plus bath towels, footwear for showers, a swimsuit, and any necessary personal toiletries, including sunscreen, etc.
4. Members of the opposite sex will not be permitted in the dorm rooms or adjacent halls.
5. Students should wear comfortable clothing and shoes. Shirts must be worn at all times. Informal (but respectable) clothing will be appropriate for the entire week. Please remember that you are representing your parents, your high school and your community.
6. You will be provided identification cards upon registration. **Please wear your ID card at all times and do not lose it.**
7. All necessary equipment will be provided by Pittsburg State University. However, students are permitted, and encouraged, to bring and use their own equipment. Any questions about equipment should be directed to the Camp Director's Trou Comeau (620-235-4724) and Josh Letner (620-240-0755).
8. Registration will take place at Nation Hall on the campus of Pittsburg State University at 9:00 AM on Wednesday, July 20th.
9. Students planning to drive their own cars to Media Camp will be required to turn their keys over to an advisor at registration and will not be allowed to use their vehicles during media camp.
10. Pittsburg State University, nor the Kansas Shrine Bowl are responsible for lost or stolen items. Please do not bring expensive jewelry or excessive amounts of money to camp.
11. The Game on Saturday will kick off at 7:00 PM, with pregame festivities beginning at 6:00 PM. Check out will be from 3:00 PM- 4:30 PM on Saturday at Pittsburg State University. During check-out time you need to load all your personal belongings brought to camp into your parents' vehicle. If for any reason you are unable to load your belongings during check-out time, you must contact Shrine Bowl staff prior to Camp.
12. Please no bunking or moving beds. There will be an inspection. There will be a fee for lost dorm keys.
13. **No drugs or alcohol at the camp. If found, police will be notified, and you will be sent home.**
