Thank you for choosing to be a part of the 1st Annual Kansas Shrine Bowl Media Camp at the 49th Annual Kansas Shrine Bowl in Pittsburg, KS! Media Camp starts with registration at 9 am on Wednesday, July 20th and ends with the Shrine Bowl Game on the evening of Saturday, July 23rd at Carnie Smith Stadium in Pittsburg.

Enclosed with this letter, you will find the following:

You will be responsible for your own transportation to Pittsburg and home again after the game. If you are planning to drive yourself to camp, you will NOT have access to your vehicle for the duration of camp. If you are being brought to camp and dropped off by a parent/guardian, they will need to be available on Saturday, July 23rd for check-out at 3 p.m. so you can load your belongings out of the dorms. Access to the dorms will not be available after the game on Saturday night.

While at camp, your expenses for meals and transportation are provided for you by the Kansas Shrine Bowl. However, you may want to bring a little extra money for personal items, snacks or souvenirs.

All necessary equipment will be provided by Pittsburg State University. However, students are encouraged to bring their own equipment if they wish. Please remember however, that the Kansas Shrine Bowl nor Pittsburg State are responsible for any lost or stolen items.

Residence hall room linens and towels will not be provided. Students should bring their own sheets – Twin XL (5” longer than regular twin size), as well as a pillow, blanket, bath towels and footwear for showers, and all necessary personal toiletries, including sunscreen.
